- Vanita Viswanath is currently the CEO of Udyogini. Udyogini works to empower poor women through enterprise - focusing on training, value chain development and market linkages in north and central Indian states.

She has also consulted with several international organizations including Oxfam International, Conservation International, DFID, UNDP and the Asian Development Bank. She was a member of a Planning Commission Working Group on Clustering and Aggregation of Enterprise in the 12th Five Year Plan.
